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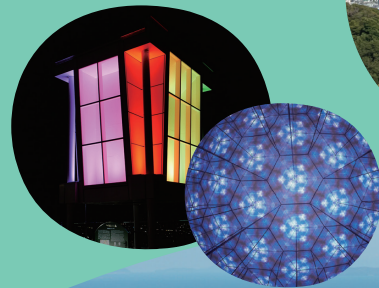
## AWAGIN BIZAN ROPEWAY – BASE STATION

Mt. Bizan, a symbol of Tokushima, is featured in the Manyoshu poetry anthology. As its name suggests, the mountain has a gentle, eyebrow-like shape. It takes about six minutes to reach the summit station, which stands at an elevation of 290 meters, from the base station. While listening to the onboard announcements, you can enjoy a panoramic view of Tokushima City from the window. On clear days, you may even see as far as Awaji Island and the Kii Peninsula.

### Opening Hours

April 1 – October 31: 9:00–21:00  
November 1 – March 31: 9:00–17:30

The "Mayugekyo" monument is an LED kaleidoscope at the observation deck, featuring approximately 4,100 LED lights, creating a mesmerizing visual display.



The Yoshino River, a first-class river flowing through Tokushima, is also known as "Shikoku Saburo" due to its breathtaking scenery that changes along its course.

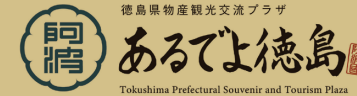
